

GETTING STARTED WITH SCHOOL BAND PROGRAM

Good morning parents and guardians!

There are a few steps to getting started with the band program here at school. First step is getting an instrument. My personal recommendation is to go through Loser's Music in Lebanon, as they are our schools designated music store for music and instruments. If you contact them via phone (1-800-522-2600), they will explain to you the ordering and financing process for the instrument. Make sure you mention the school's name and mine. They will deliver the instrument, books and supplies directly to school as a result. There is a trial period available for the each instrument, after which a financing plan for the instrument will begin. Further details are available with the representatives at Loser's.

The second step is getting your student registered with our records. Please use the following link

Fill out this form to register your student for the program. There is a nominal fee (\$85 dollars annually, \$45 for the half year rate) for participation in the instrumental music program. This too can be financed. Please contact Ellen Miscannon at Bishop McDevitt High School (717-236-7973) with questions regarding the fee. Otherwise she will mail you an invoice.

Once your student is registered and has an instrument, I will work meet with them to get them on the lesson schedule. Once they have reached a certain skill proficiency, I will welcome them to band rehearsals Wednesday mornings.
