# What to Expect

#### **FACILITY CLEANLINESS**

We will be cleaning our school daily and disinfecting and sanitizing each day after school. High touch areas will be wiped down several times during the day.

#### HANDWASHING & SANITIZER

All classrooms will have hand sanitizer and the hallways Will have stand hand sanitizers located in each hallway Additionally, there will be hand sanitizer located on the walls outside all of the bathrooms. The school nurse will instruct each cohort on proper handwashing.

#### MASK/FACE SHIELDS

Masks/face shields will be required for all Pre-K -8 students. fourteen (14) calendar days. when students are outside masks may be removed. The school nurse will instruct all students on the proper removal of masks. Students are asked have an extra mask.

#### PHYSICAL DISTANCING

Our classrooms and space will be arranged to move desks at minimum of 4 feet apart or more where feasible. Cohorts will be kept together at all times.
