Spartan Sprint vs. 5K Run/Walk

The events listed below are each separate fundraisers for our school

The Spartan Sprint For Education, (formally known as the Race For Education) is a Walk/Run-A-Thon fundraiser in which our children (with the help of their parents) solicit monetary pledges from their family & friends. Parents provide the committee with a minimum number of names & addresses so the committee can generate the mailing of informational donation flyers through the U.S. mail. The committee publishes an item "Wish List" right on the donation flyer so all donors are informed how their donation will be allocated. All proceeds from The Spartan Sprint For Education are used to purchase these items which in turn, are used directly by our children, teachers and staff. On Sprint Day (usually the last Friday in April,) our children do their part by walking/running laps for a specific time period. The PTO has conducted this fundraising event for close to 25 years.

The 5K Run/Walk is a community-unity race through the streets of Penbrook. A registration fee is paid by all participants. This 5K Run/Walk is open to the general public regardless of ability. Local businesses are encouraged to participate through sponsorships. All proceeds from the 5K Run/Walk are used toward the operating budget of the school. This School Board has conducted this fundraising event for the past 8 years.
