**NEW SCHEDULE FOR FREE GRAB & GO
BREAKFAST AND LUNCH MEALS, AND
FAMILY FOOD BOX DISTRIBUTION**



Attention Harrisburg School District Parents and Guardians:

Beginning Tuesday, April 14, 2020, the Harrisburg School District will provide five (5) "Grab and Go" breakfasts and five (5) lunch meals for students on **Tuesdays ONLY from 11:00 am to 12:30 pm**. Free family food boxes donated by the Central Pennsylvania Food Bank will be available on a first come, first served basis on **Thursdays ONLY at 4:00 pm**. Meals and food boxes will be distributed at the following Harrisburg School District locations.

Rowland Academy
John Harris Campus**

**Downey School
Ben Franklin School
Cougar Academy - Parking Lot**

If the CDC, PA Department of Health, or Governor's Office provides new guidance regarding the feeding program, it could change the operations of the food distribution. Any such changes will be communicated via the District website at www.hbgsd.us.

While schools are closed due to COVID-19, the Susquehanna Township School District will provide free meals to children through age 18. Meals (breakfast and lunch) will be provided on a first come, first served basis. Breakfasts and lunches will be nutritionally balanced. All children through age 18 must be present to receive meals.

FOR ANY STUDENT UP TO AGE 18

Who:	Any child, 18 or under, who lives within CDS's boundaries. <i>Child must be present to pick up meal.</i>
What:	Free breakfast and lunch – both meals will be given at the same time.
Where:	CD East High School AND Swatara Middle School – choose the location that is most convenient for your family.
When:	Starting March 17th, & every weekday between 8 AM– 12 noon.
How:	Drive-thru & walk up service.

Grab and Go Meals Updated April 14, 2020

Roller families:

During the state-mandated closure of schools due to Coronavirus (COVID-19), the Steelton-Highspire School District will be providing free grab and go breakfast and lunch meals to any resident children aged 18 and under.

The District's meal program will be supported through collaboration with the Pennsylvania Department of Education and the National School Lunch Program. Any child, 18 or under, who lives within the boundaries of Steelton-Highspire School District will be eligible for free breakfast and lunch.

The **CHILD MUST BE PRESENT** in order to receive the meal due to National School Lunch Program reimbursement guidelines. Please be mindful that there will be perishable items within your breakfast/lunch and some items may need to be refrigerated.

Who: Any child, 18 or under, who lives within SHSD's boundaries.

What: Free breakfast and lunch – both meals will be given at the same time, although the breakfast being provided is for the following day.

Where: Grab & Go will be available at the following locations:

Highspire: Memorial Park Concession Stand, Lumber Street

Steelton: Mt. Zion Church, Second Street & Locust Street

New Hope Primitive Baptist Church, Second Street & Mohn Street

When: Starting March 17th, and every weekday between 10:30AM – 11:30AM during the school district closure

If the United States Department of Education, Governor's Office and/or the Pennsylvania Department of Education provide new program guidance, it could modify and/or change the operations of the food distribution.

Any such changes would be communicated through our District website. Please continue to monitor the district website for important information. Thank you for your patience with District officials as we adjust to ever-changing circumstances during this unprecedented time.
