- i. Mums: orders are due Sept. 9 and mum pick up is Sept. 23 and 24
- ii. Trivia Night: Sept. 30 at 7 pm with registration due by Sept. 23 and cost is \$25/person with all proceeds going to the school. Food and alcohol/non-alcohol beverages will be available at the event. Teams will consist of 6-8 people and visa gift cards are prizes. PTO suggested a donation of \$200 to cover additional prizes there were no objections from anyone attending the meeting so PTO will provide a donation.
- iii. Restaurant Night: planning on having one on the 3rd Tuesday of each month. Restaurants donate a portion to the school; Sept. 20th Bellia's pizza on Linglestown Road (Restaurant will donate at least \$100 or up to 15-20% of sales); Oct 18th Tuskers; other dates and restaurants will be made available once determined.
- d. Zoom vs. In-person PTO Meetings: consensus on tonight's call is that zoom meetings are preferred by the vast majority of parents with some interest in 1 or 2 special in-person PTO meetings per school year. Colleen suggested having one in-person meeting during the first half of the school year and one during the second half.

IV. PTO Committee Reports

- a. President:
 - i. Calendar includes all PTO meetings and events as well as school wide big events. The PTO calendar is attached to these meeting minutes.
 - ii. Book fair September 13-15. Sign up genius sent out Sept. 6 with a schedule of when kids will be shopping. There is still availability for volunteering and some days have large breaks, so if you can only cover part of a shift just let Colleen Sanders know via email. The book fair will also be open during back-to-school night.
 - iii. Boosterthon this event was a huge fundraiser last year. This year we are planning on doing it in-house using Pledgestar to handle money. Pledgestar costs 7% of total with a maximum of \$995. Last year's Boosterthon required a \$2000 down payment and required a higher percent of total donations. No date has been set yet but we are looking at early November. Leah Booker volunteered to do something more dance related instead of videos.
 - iv. Hot lunch some parents are interested in more days of hot lunch; in the past the PTO has sponsored (funded) and staffed it. PTO will check with Ms. Shonda to see how it works but thought that she orders food but PTO pays and staff it. Colleen will talk with Mrs. Pronio and Ms. Shonda

- b. Vice President (Shannon Sprow): golf tournament Friday, Nov. 4. Still need volunteers to sell raffle tickets, run beverage carts, meet caterers, etc. Also, looking for sponsors and golfers. Registration needs to get up on the website and Facebook page. The student directory was a pdf and book last year but this year they are hoping to pull information from existing school data asking parents if they'd like their information included. More info on the student directory will be available on back-to-school night.
- c. Treasurer (Leah Booker): PTO was able to purchase signs for the school and fund the pool party. We have fundraisers coming up. Some receipts aren't making it to Leah through school so Leah requests that when submitting receipts, please email her with a picture of it, what it is for, the amount, and who the check goes to. Leah will then snail mail the check. Also, please provide monthly receipts for use of the PTO card. Leah's contact information is bia2001@gmail.com or 717-579-8042.
- d. Secretary (Tracey Mumma): new to position with nothing to report.
- e. Hot Lunch: no report other than it starts Wednesday, Sept. 7.
- f. Uniform Exchange (Caroline Krall): late summer exchange when well. There is lots of inventory so if you need it email coordinators and they will get the items asap. Another uniform exchange in the spring/April. Donations of 1-2 wire racks are needed (wheeled or stationary). Nikki A. has one to donate. Parents commented that the fall uniform exchange was a well-organized event.
- g. Social (Dana Dwyer): movie night this summer was well attended and the second movie night was canceled due to weather. Currently working on a possible October movie night. The pool party had a huge turnout and went well. The fall festival will occur on October 29 and will be in a similar format as last year.
- h. Donuts/Pancakes (Kelly, Jen, Nikki): September 18 after the 9:30 mass will have donuts, coffee, and juice.
- i. Santa Shop: no report.
- j. Spring Festival: festival was a lot of work but had a good turnout with an unexpected bonus of over \$1200.
- k. Fundraising: still need a chair for this committee. Erin R. is running the butter braids fundraiser. R&K sub fundraiser is already set up for delivery on October 31st with orders starting on October 10th. Another fundraising idea is Little Caesar's pizza which ships directly to buyers and we make \$6/pizza. It was suggested that an opt out of fundraisers be provided. The group decided to not provide this as an option, stating that there is no requirement to fundraise, so if a family is not interested in doing so, they do not have to. Another suggestion was to add an option (such as a box on fundraising order forms) for those who do not want to buy the item being sold but who want to donate money. PTO is looking

- to fund bigger projects so want to optimize our fundraising but noted that fundraising is not required so parents can pick and choose what and if any fundraising they want to participate in.
- I. Outreach (Megan): two school signs one at the school and one at the church that state now enrolling PreK 8 with contact info about school. They are hoping to put the signs up no later than the spring to help recruit new students. Sara Hancock has been in contact with Mrs. Pronio and Mrs. C. about updating the school website as it is hard to navigate and not very user friendly. Megan also put out handouts for specific grades to help advertise school. It was suggested that a sign be purchased for and put up at St. Matthews.
- m. SCRIP (Mary Fox, Emily Nordfors): scrip is under-utilized but we could be getting more for the school. The school gets gift cards (physical and digital) at a discounted rate and the difference goes half to the school and half goes towards tuition. The rebates vary by store and discounts vary at different times of the year. The holiday season is coming so keep an eye on the bonuses. In the App you can order physical gift cards. Orders received by Monday night, will go home with your kid on Friday. More information can be found at http://stmmparishschool.org/Scrip.

V. Parent Questions and/or Concerns
