Pre-K 3:

Pre-K 4/5

- The prekindergarten program is developmentally based, with a greater emphasis on academic learning and a lot of small group instruction.
- Our program promotes **social and emotional growth** through play, interest centers and academic instruction.
- Our curriculum aims to help children prepare for developmental/academic milestones set for kindergarten in the areas of language and literacy, math, science, technology and the arts.
- A **balanced literacy approach** is the core of our reading program.
- Children study letter names and sounds and are encouraged to read simple words and books appropriate to their individual reading levels.
- Writing is taught through instruction in the formation of letters, words, sentences, and personal journals.
- **Mathematics** is taught with a "hands-on" approach through the use of manipulatives and projects.
- Science is a key curriculum area for our prekindergarten students that includes interactive STEM enhanced activities.
- Music & Movement and Arts & Crafts are also integral to this program.
- Teachers provide a mix of independent, teacher-directed, and small group learning experiences and activities.
- Afternoon sessions enhance learning through interest center activities.
- Our students share faith and academic activities with their prayer partners in sixth grade.
