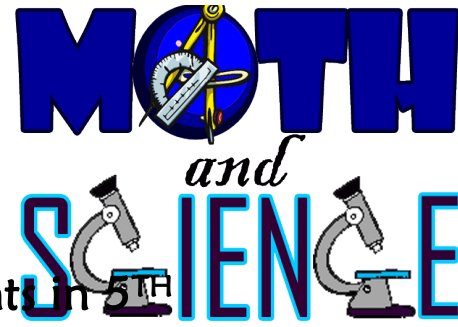


Welcome to 5<sup>th</sup> Grade!

As for Science, as I mentioned, I will try to “chunk” the material into smaller quizzes instead of big tests. So, even though the paper your child brings home may say “test” at the top, it should be considered a quiz.
