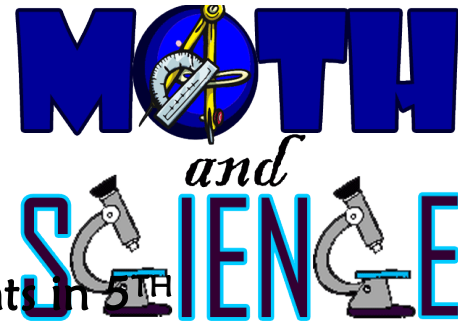


Welcome to 5th Grade!

Parents: This is how I plan to assess the students in 5th Grade Math & Science. As I mentioned at the “Back To School Night” I will teach a concept for about 2 days and if the students seem to understand the concept I will give them a Test or Quiz on that particular concept. Most of what we have been doing I had taught in my 4th grade classes during my career at Boiling Springs. As we progress, the material will get more challenging and I may have to have a longer duration of time before each quiz or test. As for Science, as I mentioned, I will try to “chunk” the material into smaller quizzes instead of big tests. So, even though the paper your child brings home may say “test” at the top, it should be considered a quiz.

5th Grade Math: 5-1: Workbook P. 37 (1-14)

5-2: Testing on Division

5th Grade Science: Students can continue doing 3 or 4 vocab cards a night for Ch 2 Lessons 1-4.

These were started in class before Thanksgiving.

Parents, I have adjusted the weights on the science & math grading scale in the hopes that this helps in making the grades a bit more in line with the work we are doing in class. Please be patient with me, using the “weighted” system is new to me. Respectfully, Mr. Rich.

6th Grade Science: Students can continue with doing 3-4 vocab cards a night for Ch3 Sections 1-3. These were started before Thanksgiving.

6th Grade must have their “Childhood Diseases” surveys ready to be copied by Friday January 12th. The deadline was extended till the end of the day today January 16th. Several pairs of students did not turn their surveys in. You may want to check with your child. Each day they are late they will be docked 2 pts.
