Grade 6 Social Studies Project

Christmas Around the World Project Social Studies, Grade 6 Option 1

1. Research your assigned country to find out about their Christmas traditions including religious significance, Santa Claus, decorations, food, music, etc. You must use at least 2 sources.
2. Take your research and write a report that is a minimum of three paragraphs long. Remember to put your research into your own words because if you copy straight from your source, then it is plagiarism.
3. Type your paragraphs, use Times New Roman font 12 and double space.
4. At the top of the page put your name on the left side of the paper and the date on the right. Be sure these are typed also.
5. Create a decorative cover that shows some of the traditions that you learned in your research. It may be hand drawn or computer generated by you. The title on the front cover should be: Christmas in _____ - Put the name of your country in the blank. Make the cover colorful.

Option 2

1. Research your assigned country to find out about their Christmas traditions including religious significance, Santa Claus, decorations, food, music, etc. You must use at least 2 sources.
2. Select 4 of the traditions to focus on and type a 3-5 sentence descriptions of each one.
3. On a poster board provided by the teacher showcase these 4 traditions on the poster. Divide the poster into 4 sections. At the top of the poster in the middle, place your title following the format of above.
4. Hand draw, with colored pencils, an illustration of each paragraph that you have written about a tradition. You will have 4 illustrations on your poster.
5. Type your paragraphs, neatly cut out your paragraphs and mount them to the bottom of the corresponding illustration on the poster. You can mount your paragraphs on a background paper that compliments your pictures if you would like to do that. Be creative and use lots of color. Each of your illustrations should cover all the white of the poster.
6. Put your name on the back of the paper.
