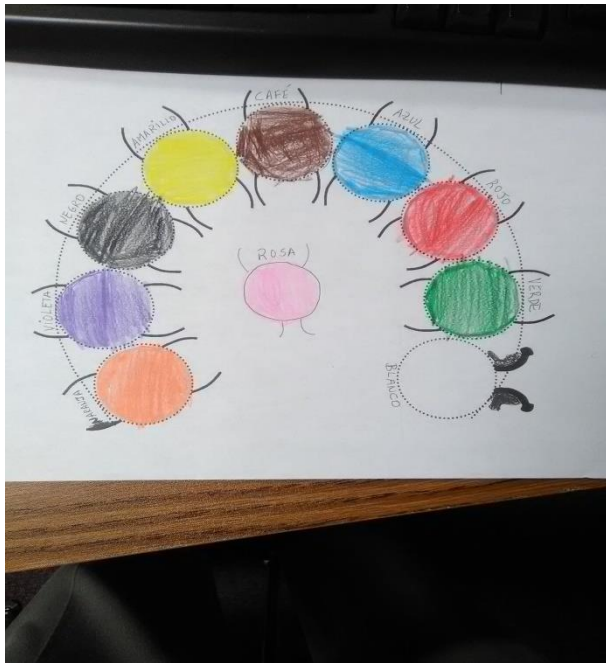
Pre-K: Body parts, colors



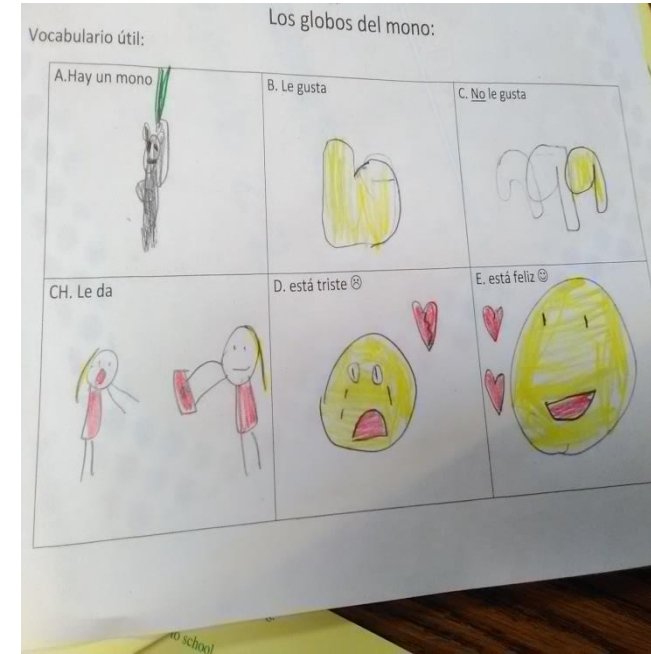
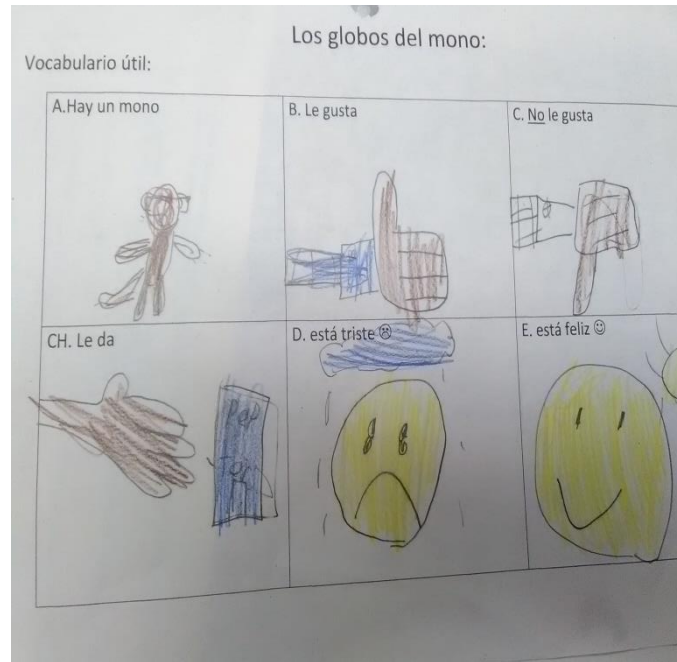
Kindergarten: Colors, numbers
