In science we are starting Chapter 6, Saving Earth's Resources. The students will be learning and working with different types of rocks, along with learning about minerals. There are 12 vocab words and definitions the students will need to learn. We will also be discussing soils.

I gave both my fourth graders their Science Study Guide. 4-1 will have a test this Friday. I would also like to give 4-2 the same test on Friday. I will talk with Mrs. Kuntz. I will let the students know tomorrow. So, please have your child study the Science guide and vocab cards this evening and tomorrow evening. Thank you.

We will be finishing up the story in LA, The Cricket in Time Square this week. I'm planning on having a test this Friday.

MATH: We did a math maintenance sheet today which included 4 basic draw the next picture in the pattern, 4 one digit times a 2 or 3 digit number, 8 addition and subtraction facts, and 4 write the numeral for numbers in word form. These were facts that they learned in 3rd grade and reviewed so far this trimester. This will be added to their report card grade.

Please note that I will now be posting Mrs. Kuntz's Social Studies homework, etc. as she gives me the information.

Lastly, at Back to School night I talked about the classroom "oops" program for incomplete homework and not getting their planners signed. I usually end the "oops" at the end of October. After much reflection I decided to keep the "oops" policy for the school year. Each student will be permitted three "oops" before receiving a Reflect and Correct for lunch detention. Now parents will receive notification each time an "oops" is used. Please remember though there are no "oops" for behavior. Thank you for your understand in this important matter.
