LANGUAGE ARTS

Reading: The story we are currently working on is an informational text called "My Librarian is a Camel." In this story we are learning about some very interesting ways that books are delivered to children in remote parts of the world.

Spelling: This week's list will contain words with long and short /i/ sounds.

Grammar: We are nearing the end of our section on sentences. We will recognize and properly form *compound sentences*, and identify and correct *run-on sentences*. We will thoroughly review all of the material we covered on sentences before having a test early next week.

MATH
