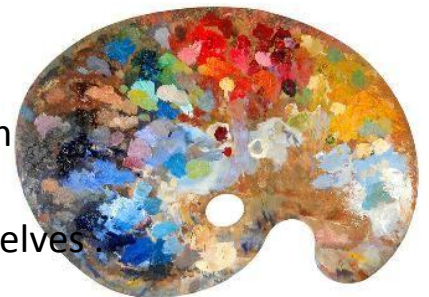
Week of the 24th

K-2 Projects using sponges and paint,

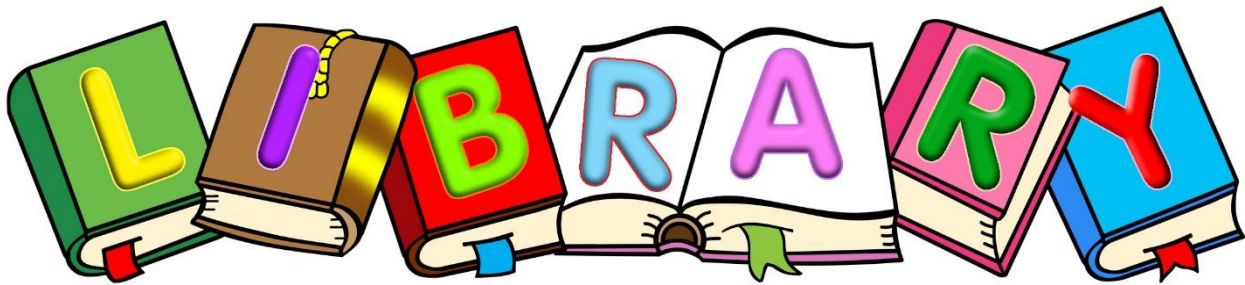
Grades 3-4 : Projects with apples and paint and drawing cartoon buses.
