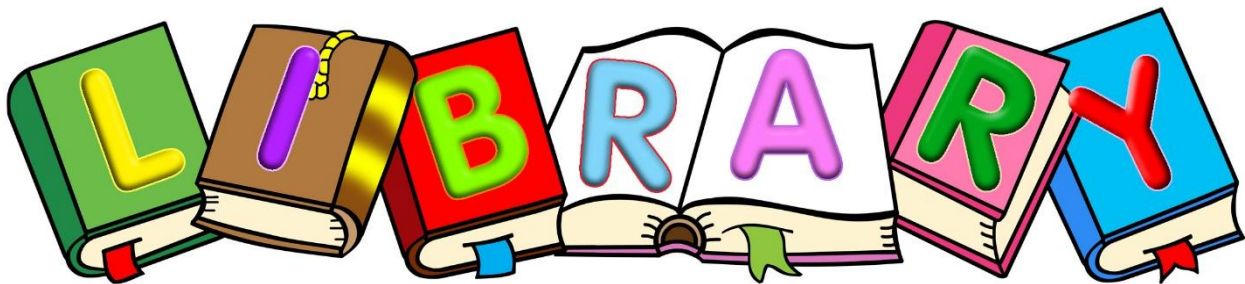
Most classes are working on fall/Halloween projects.
