The present tense of the –ar, -er & -ir verbs (endings)

	<u>-AR</u>	<u>- ER</u>	<u>- IR</u>
I -----yo-----	o	o	o
you (informal)---- tú-	as	es	es
he/she/you(f)----él/ella/usted -----	a	e	e
we -----nosotros/nosotras-----	amos	emos	imos
they/you (all)----ellos/ellas/ustedes-----	an	en	en

Example:

Using the verb -to study- ESTUDIAR

yo estudio

tú estudias

él/ella/usted estudia

nosotros estudiamos

ellos/ellas/ustedes estudian

The verb – to eat- COMER

yo como

tú comes

él/ella/usted come

nosotros comemos

ellos/ellas/ustedes comen

The verb –to live- VIVIR

yo vivo

tú vives

él/ella/usted vive

nosotros vivimos

ellos/ellas/ustedes viven

Examples on how to introduce mom & dad. (3rd person- he/she)

Mi madre se llama Sara.

Ella es de Virginia.

Ella tiene cuarenta años.

My mom's name is Sarah.

She is from Virginia.

She is forty years old.

Le gusta cocinar y cantar.
No le gustan los gatos.
Ella es amable, bonita y alta.
Su cumpleaños es el primero
de mayo.

Mi padre se llama Tomás.
Él es de Harrisburg.
Él tiene cuarenta y dos años.
Le gusta trabajar y los carros.
No le gusta el fútbol.
Él es estricto, alto y serio.
Su cumpleaños es el veinte
de enero.

She likes to cook and sing.
She doesn't like cats.
She is kind, pretty and tall.

Her birthday is the 1st of May.

My dad's name is Thomas.
He is from Harrisburg.
He is forty two years old.
He likes to work and cars.
He doesn't like soccer.
He is strict, tall and serious.

His birthday is January 20.
