A Peek At The Week:

Religion: This week we will finish up chapter 20. In chapter 20 we will focus on Jesus offers himself for us and the Eucharist. We will have a test on chapter 20 on Tuesday. There is an interactive review game on christourlife.org. In chapter 21 we will focus on how Jesus helped a Roman Soldier and how Jesus gives himself for us.

Language Arts: This week we will continue to work on lesson 16 in our Journeys reading program. The story for lesson 16 is "Mr. Tanen's Tie Trouble" and the genre for this selection is realistic fiction. The focus skills for lesson 16 include story structure, infer and predict, homographs, and base words and endings -ed and -ing when you double the final consonant. We will have our lesson 16 Vocabulary and Phonics tests on Thursday. We will have our lesson 16 Spelling and Reading tests on Friday.

Math: This week we will continue to work on geometry. This week we will focus on congruent figures, lines of symmetry, slides, flips, and turns, and ways to make figures. We will have a progress check on lessons 6-9 from chapter 6 on Thursday.

Science and Social Studies/Creative Writing: This week we will be working in our Scholastic News Magazines. We will also be doing a STEM activity on making symmetrical butterflies.
