A Peek At The Week:

Religion: This week we will introduce Unit 4. Unit 4 prepares us to receive the sacrament of First Holy Communion. This week we will focus on the story of Jesus feeding 5,000 people with 12 loaves of bread and 2 fish and St. Elizabeth Ann Seton. **We will have a test on chapter 15 on Thursday.**

Language Arts: This week we will continue to work on lesson 12 in our Journeys Reading Program. The story for lesson 12 is "Ah, Music" and the genre for this selection is informational text. The focus skills for lesson 12 include the vowel teams -ai and -ay, fact and opinion, and compound sentences. **We will have our lesson 12 Phonics and Grammar tests on Wednesday. We will have our lesson 12 Vocabulary and Reading Comprehension tests on Thursday. We will have our lesson 12 Spelling test on Friday.**

Math: This week we will continue to work on Chapter 7, Money and Time. This week we will focus on dollars and cents, time to the hour and half hour, five minute intervals, and telling time to the quarter hour. **We will have a progress check on lessons 4-9 on Tuesday.**

Science and Social Studies/Creative Writing: This week we will work in our Scholastic News Magazines. We will also write Easter Egg stories and "Hatching into Spring" stories.
