

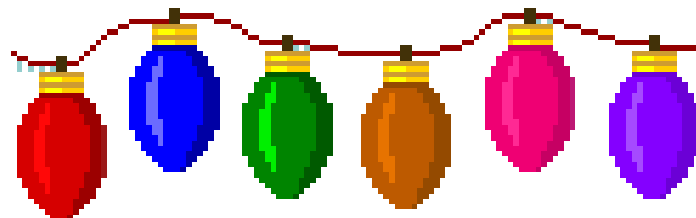

A Peek At The Week:

Religion: We will be spending our Religion time this week practicing our songs for the Christmas Pageant. Our class is singing “Silver Bells,” “O’Christmas Tree,” and “The Magic of Christmas.”

Language Arts: This week we will continue to work on lesson 7 in our Journeys Reading Program. The story for lesson 7 is "The Ugly Vegetables" and the genre for this selection is realistic fiction. The focus skills for lesson 7 include double final consonants and -ck, proper nouns, homophones, and story structure. Cursive writing this week will focus on lowercase letters -k, -r, -s, and -j. We will have our lesson 7 Vocabulary and Phonics tests on Wednesday. We will have our lesson 7 Spelling and Reading tests on Thursday.

Math: This week we will continue to work on adding 2-digit numbers. This week we will focus on regrouping when adding 2-digit numbers, estimating sums, and rewriting 2-digit addition from horizontal to vertical format. We will have a Progress Check on lessons 1-6 on Wednesday.

Science and Social Studies/Creative Writing: This week we will continue to prepare for the Christmas and Advent season. This week we will write stories about our Christmas tree.
