

A Peek At The Week:

Religion: This week we will be working on activities related to the Christmas season. We will make angel tree ornaments, advent wreaths, learn about the 4th Wise Man, and write stories about why Christmas is important.

Language Arts: This week we will introduce lesson 7 in our Journeys reading program. The story for lesson 7 is “The Ugly Vegetables” and the genre for this selection is realistic fiction. The focus skills for lesson 7 include double final consonants and –ck, proper nouns, homophones, story structure, and informational writing. **We will have our lesson 7 Phonics and Vocabulary tests on Wednesday. We will have our lesson 7 Spelling and Reading tests on Thursday.**

Math: This week we will continue to work on Chapter 4 in Math. In Chapter 4 we will be learning about adding 2-digit numbers. This week we will focus on rewriting 2-digit addition problems from horizontal to vertical form and adding 3 addends of 2-digit numbers. **We will have a progress check on lessons 7-9 in chapter 4 on Thursday.**

Social Studies: This week we will work in our Scholastic News Magazines.

Science: We will be doing a STEM activity on Gingerbread Houses.

Creative Writing: This week we will writing Christmas themed Squiggle stories.
